Join and take advantage of discounted rates in lift tickets, season-long equipment rentals, merchant discounts and ski and snowboard group lessons to its members. We welcome both skiers and snowboarders. Many benefits are still being negotiated at time of publication.

1. Discounted Lift Tickets at Local Hills

Show your membership card and get daily lift ticket discounts at: Calabogie, Camp Fortune, Edelweiss, Mont Avila, Mont Blanc, Mont Cascade, Mont Gabriel, Mont Olympia, Mont Pakenham, Mont Ste Marie, Mont St Sauveur, Morin Heights and Vorlage. Last season's daily discounts ranged from \$5.00 - 11.00. 2. Discounted Group Lessons at Local Hills

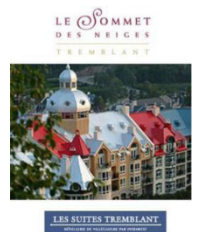
4. Mont Tremblant "Ski Max" Tickets - \$59.99-\$63.00 vs \$103.03 (2016-17 prices)

Last season we were able to offer Mont Tremblant "Ski Max" lift tickets to members for \$59.99 (taxes in). Some extra "Ski Max" tickets are usually available from the office as well. 5. Discounted Accommodation at Mont Tremblant

Each season we arrange for deeply discounted accommodation at the 4-star **Le Sommet des Neiges**. Le Sommet des Neiges is at the base of the gondola for true ski-in / ski-out convenience (just 100 feet from the gondola!). Room prices are per suite - NOT per person and taxes and royalty are NOT included. No minimum number of nights required and last season we had three periods of savings!

Day Trips depart from the Wal-Mart Trainyards parking lot in the northwest corner of the Train Yards shopping area at 450 Terminal Ave, Ottawa and make a second stop at Montée Paiement in the Carrefour Versant Plaza in Gatineau.
